PRCS- Emergency Flood Response (16 - December 2022)

SITUATION:

Torrential monsoon rains triggered the most severe flooding in Pakistan's recent history, washing away villages and almost 33 million people have been affected and leaving 20.6 million individuals in need of immediate, lifesaving support, and at increased risk of waterborne diseases, drowning and malnutrition. Hundreds of thousands of homes have been damaged or destroyed, while many public health facilities, water systems, and schools have been destroyed or damaged. As the floodwaters have receded, the crisis has become an acute survival crisis. People are fighting a losing battle against severe acute malnutrition, diarrhea, malaria, fever, typhoid, acute respiratory infections, and painful skin conditions. As well as physical ailments, the longer the crisis continues, the greater the risk to mental health.

PRCS is responding in 53 districts across the country, helping to deliver safe drinking water, lifesaving medical supplies, emergency shelter & latrines, food parcels, and household essential items for families.



Honorable Chairman PRCS, Secretary General PRCS, and Country Head IFRC distributed household essential items among flood-affected communities of Sindh.

Bilateral Support from RCRC Partners:

IFRC	The IFRC launched the first phase of DREF operation in KP and Balochistan worth PKR: 40 million and keeping in view the evolving situation, launched 2nd DREF and expanded its flood operation in additional 08 districts. Based on the devastated situation expanded its interventions and launched the initial Emergency Appeal (25 mil CHF) and which has further revised and requested for (55 million CHF) and IFRC will prioritize to support the 35 targeted districts across the country.
ICRC	ICRC is supporting 12 Mobile Health Units in flood-affected areas of (02) KP and (10) Baluchistan and all 12 MHUs are fully functional and treated 37,783 patients and 4,258 people were reached through health and hygiene promotion sessions. Additionally, 03 Set of dressings for burns and 05 sets of injectable were donated by ICRC for the floods response. Furthermore, provided free Phone Call services to 1016 households under PRCS, Restoring Family Links Program.
GRC	GRC is supporting in the provision of 20,200 food parcels, kitchen sets, 15,300 hygiene kits 2600, Blankets 884 Sindh and KPK. Out of the total PRCS has distributed 11,374 food parcels (8,874 in Sindh and 2,500 in KP), 13,226 hygiene kits (7,716 in Sindh, 5,510 in KP), and conducted hygiene sessions for 3,033 individuals in KP with the support of GRC.
Nor-Cross	Nor-Cross is supporting PRCS in the health and WASH sector, deployed 7 MHUs in KP where treated 55,717 patients were treated and 39,461 people were provided health and hygiene promotion sessions. Nor-Cross supporting in 6 districts of Sindh in distributing NFIs in Sindh subsequently Jerry can 5,138, Hygiene kits 5,070, Hygiene kits Children 106, Buckets 4916. In addition to that distributed 6,529 hygiene kits, 6,529 jerry can, and 4,450 buckets.
IRC	The Iranian Red Crescent has provided PRCS 1,000 tents, 4,000 blankets and 2,000 mats. Which will be distributed in effected districts of Balochistan.
TRC	Supported 13,355 families in Balochistan, Sindh and KP and provided 2,000 tents, 2,700 blankets, 1,800 hygiene kits, 600 Jerry cans, 1,500 LLINs, 335 mattresses, 150 pairs of rubber boots, 20 pieces of raincoats and 140 paddles in Baluchistan. Additionally, distributed 6,000 Dry ration packs (50 kg) in Baluchistan, Sindh and KP. Furthermore, is planning to support 1,300 households through cash grant in Sindh and Balochistan.
KRC	KRC has extended its support and distributed NFIs including 160 tents, 1,120 blankets, 320 jerry cans 160 hygiene kits, 640 mosquito nets and 160 kitchen sets in Dadu.
QRC	QRC provided support to the PRCS flood response and distributed NFIs comprised of 1,000 blankets, 200 jerry cans, and Tents among the 200 flood effected families in Mirpur Khas, Sindh. In second phase QRC is going to support 400 families for NFIs and food
IRC	The Iranian Red Crescent has provided PRCS 1,000 tents, 4,000 blankets and 2,000 mats. Which will be distributed in effected districts of Balochistan.
